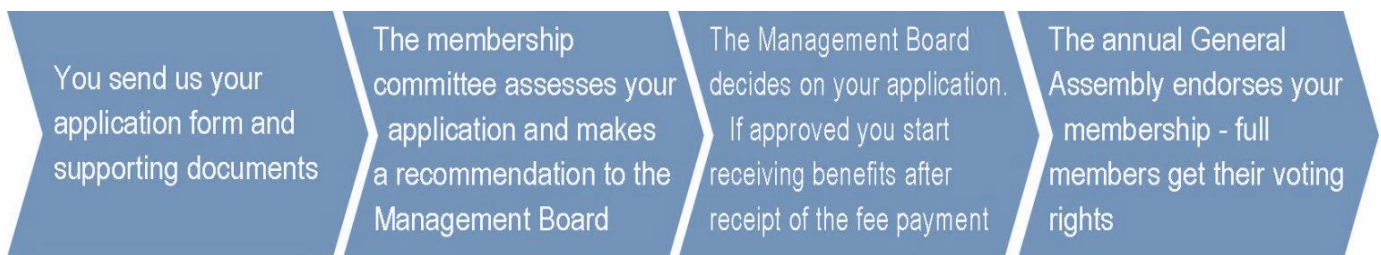
Membership criteria

Membership is open to all organisations and individuals with an interest in the rights and well-being of children and young people.

Eurochild's members cover a broad range of types of organisations with very diverse areas of activities and geographical scopes.

In order to reflect the amplitude of our membership and guarantee adequate visibility to all our members, they are classified as follows: national partner networks (the go-to child rights network in each country – appointed by the management board), national/sub-national organisations (including networks), international organisations/ networks, academic and research institutions, public/statutory bodies, child and youth-led organisations, individuals.

Application and assessment process

Membership fees

Membership fees for full members range from 100 to 1000€ according to the annual income of your organisation,^{} with the exception of academic and research institutions and public/statutory bodies which have a flat fee of 250€ and 500€ respectively (unless their annual accounts justify a lower fee). The fee for associate members is 100€.*

A reduction of 25% is granted to members who are also in membership of a Eurochild National Partner Network. New members joining in the course of the year are granted a reduced fee according to the number of months already elapsed that year on the day of approval by the Management Board.
